2009 SPECIAL MUNICIPAL RUN-OFF ELECTION
*A Resolution Canvassing and Declaring the Results
Of a Special Municipal Run-Off Election held on Tuesday, December 8, 2009
Regarding the Election of Selma City Board of Education Members*

WHEREAS, Ala. Code §11-46-46(a) provides that at the time appointed by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama to canvass the returns of the election, the City Clerk shall deliver to the City Council the envelopes addressed to the governing body, which were delivered to him/ her by the returning officers of the several wards in the city immediately after the votes had been counted and the returns thereof prepared; *and*

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama has received said envelopes from the City Clerk which contain the returns of the special municipal run-off election held December 8, 2009 for the election of Selma City Board of Education Members; *and*

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama has tabulated the provisional ballots which have been certified by the board of registrars as cast by registered and qualified voters for the purpose of making election returns and the City Council canvassing the same; *and*

WHEREAS, the City of Selma, Alabama has canvassed all returns including provisional returns to determine the number of votes cast for each candidate during the special municipal run-off election and hereby ascertain the results as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

CHAIRMAN OF THE SELMA CITY BOARD OF EDUCATION

Henry Hicks, Sr. received a majority of the votes for the Office of Chairman of the Selma City Board of Education, and is hereby declared duly elected as Chairman of the Selma City Board of Education and shall take office in accordance with the provisions of Act No. 2008-498.

DISTRICT 1 OF THE SELMA CITY BOARD OF EDUCATION

Holland Powell received a majority of the votes for District 1 of the Selma City Board of Education, and is hereby declared duly elected, within District 1 as a member of the Selma City Board of Education and shall take office in accordance with the provisions of Act No. 2008-498.

DISTRICT 2 OF THE SELMA CITY BOARD OF EDUCATION

BRENDA RANDOLPH OBOMANU received a majority of the votes for District 2 of the Selma City Board of Education, and is hereby declared duly elected within District 2 as a member of the Selma City Board of Education and shall take office in accordance with the provisions of Act No. 2008-498.

DISTRICT 3 OF THE SELMA CITY BOARD OF EDUCATION

Frank Chestnut, Jr. received a majority of the votes for District 3 of the Selma City Board of Education, and is hereby declared duly elected within District 3 as a member of the Selma City Board of Education and shall take office in accordance with the provisions of Act No. 2008-498.

DISTRICT 4 OF THE SELMA CITY BOARD OF EDUCATION

Udo F. Ufomadu received a majority of the votes for the District 4 of the Selma City Board of Education, and is hereby declared duly elected within District 4 as a member of the Selma City Board of Education and shall take office in accordance with the provisions of Act No. 2008-498.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Selma shall execute and deliver a *Certificate of Election* to Henry Hicks, Sr. as Chairman of the Selma City Board of Education, Holland Powell for District 1 of the Selma City Board of Education, Brenda Randolph Obomanu for District 2 of the Selma City Board of Education, Frank Chestnut, Jr. for District 3 of the Selma City Board of Education and Udo F. Ufomadu for District 4 of the Selma City Board of Education.

The City Clerk is hereby instructed to file a copy of said *Certificate of Election* in the Office of Probate Judge of Dallas County, Alabama and the Judge of Probate shall file said Certificates in the same manner that he files the declaration of the results of election of county offices.


